

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have completed our review of the Indianapolis Metropolitan Planning Organization (IMPO) Amendment to the FY 2009-2012 Indianapolis Regional Transportation Improvement Program (IRTIP; see enclosed Resolution No. 10-IMPO-001 dated February 17, 2010). USEPA and IDEM comments support the finding that all applicable Clean Air Act conformity requirements have been addressed.

Therefore, we find the 2010 1st Quarter Amendment to the FY 2009-2012 IRTIP demonstrates conformity for 8-hour ozone and the annual standard for PM 2.5 as required by the conformity rule.

Attached to this e-mail is a copy of an amendment to the Indianapolis MPO's 2009-2012 TIP and the signed approval resolution (10-IMPO-001) for your use in determining air quality conformity. This amendment was approved by the Indianapolis Regional Transportation Council's Policy Committee at a public hearing on February 17th, 2010 after a 15 day public review and comment period. No comments were received from the public prior to or during the public hearing. The Interagency Consultation Group was provided a copy of the proposed amendment and no significant comments were received.

All of the approved (exempt and non-exempt) amendments were found by the MPO to be either exempt as defined by 40 CFR 93.126 or consistent with the amended 2030 Indianapolis Regional Transportation Plan.

Resolution Number 10-IMPO-001

A RESOLUTION amending the 2009-2012 Indianapolis Regional Transportation Improvement Program.

WHEREAS, the 2009-2012 Indianapolis Regional Transportation Improvement Program (IRTIP) incorporates projects proposed by local governments and agencies within the Indianapolis Metropolitan Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, the projects contained in the proposed IRTIP amendment have been reviewed as to their immediate impact and importance to the continued improvement of the transportation system operating within the area; and

WHEREAS, changing conditions necessitate periodic amendments to the IRTIP; and

WHEREAS, section 176(c) of the Clean Air Act, amended in 1990, required that the Transportation Conformity Rule establish criteria and procedures by which the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), and metropolitan planning organizations (MPOs) determine the conformity of federally funded or approved highway and transit plans, programs, and projects to state implementation plans (SIPs) prepared for criteria pollutants; and

WHEREAS, the MPO consulted with the Interagency Consultation Group and the agencies did not take exception to the MPO finding that (1) each project in the TIP as amended is consistent with the design concept and scope of the project that was modeled in the most recent conformity demonstration, (2) the open-to-traffic date of each project in the TIP as amended is consistent with the open-to-traffic dates in the most recent conformity demonstration, (3) that the previous emissions analysis meets the requirements of 40 CFR 93.118 and demonstrate conformity of the TIP as amended; and


WHEREAS, the proposed IRTIP amendments were made available for public comment and comments received were provided to the Indianapolis Regional Transportation Council Policy Committee (IRTC); and

WHEREAS, the IRTC Policy Committee is the approval body for all transportation-related activities of the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Indianapolis Urbanized Area under applicable U.S. Department of Transportation regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the IRTC hereby approves the amendment to the 2009-2012 Indianapolis Regional Transportation Improvement Program as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

The above and foregoing resolution was adopted this 17th day of February 2010 by the IRTC Policy Committee.

SUBJECT: ESTIMATE OF COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH FORT WAYNE NOISE WALL CHANGES
DATE: 3/5/2010

The worst case scenario cost estimates are used for the following projects with a description of the area in question. These are costs associated with changes due to errors and inconsistencies in the original noise analysis.

For the purposes of these estimates a new wall has an associated cost of \$20/square foot. Wall removal was estimated at a cost of \$8/square foot, based off of the cost from contract IR-28937, the removal of sound barriers at Washington Center Road and I-69 in Fort Wayne. In the case of a wall being raised, the cost of a brand new wall is being used from the ground up because although the panels will be reused, the time and cost of removing and replacing the post structures are not known at this time. Therefore the new wall cost of \$20/square foot is used as a conservative estimate.

The first project is a new wall on I-69 just southeast of Bass Road for the Hickory Pointe housing development. The wall has a cost of \$20,600 per benefited receiver. The total length of the project is 900 feet, with a total wall area of 14,400 square feet. The estimated cost for this wall is \$288,000.

The second project is an extension of the existing wall just northwest of Dupont Road on I-69 for the nearby Autumn Ridge neighborhood and golf course. The wall extension has a cost of \$7,860 per benefited receiver. The total length of the project is 4,600 feet, with a total wall area of 62,000 square feet. The estimated cost of this wall is \$1,240,000.

The third project is increasing the height of the walls south of Covington Road on I-69. The east and west walls both need to be raised. If the east wall were to be constructed from scratch, it would be 2,890 feet long with a total wall area of 50,000 square feet, at a cost of approximately \$1,000,000. If the west wall were to be constructed from scratch, it would be 4,300 feet long with a total wall area of 68,000 square feet, at a cost of approximately \$1,350,000. The total estimated cost of the Covington Road wall project is \$2,350,000.

The fourth project is removing a section of noise walls in the southeast quadrant of the I-69 and Coldwater Road Interchange. The request is from the owners of the Marriott Hotel. The project consists of removing 510 feet of wall with a total area of 6,100 square feet, at a cost of approximately \$49,000.

Therefore to complete all of the above mentioned projects, the total estimated cost is approximately \$3,930,000.

FHWA has also determined that previous CMAQ funded projects to purchase equipment have not been implemented due to there not being an established process at INDOT for such local projects. FHWA is therefore withholding an eligibility finding for additional equipment procurement projects until a process with the respective Districts to implement such Local Public Agency (LPA) CMAQ equipment purchase projects is documented and is in place.

INDOT has prepared an equipment contract template that could be used. FHWA hereby requests that INDOT address questions such as:

1. Who at INDOT is responsible for facilitating these contracts thru the INDOT process?
2. Who at INDOT is to sign the contract?
3. Who is responsible for preparing the environmental document for these contracts, and when will this be done?
4. After the environmental document is approved, who is responsible for requesting federal authorization of funds in the FHWA Fiscal Management Information System (FMIS)?
5. After federal approval is given in FMIS, who is responsible for preparing the purchase orders for these contracts?
6. How will the local agency be notified they can proceed and purchase the equipment?
7. Who at the District will receive and review LPA billings, and then process payments in the INDOT accounting system?
8. Who is responsible for closing out these contracts after they are completed?
9. Who is responsible for reporting the status of these contracts and their amounts to the Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs), for use in managing their CMAQ funds?

Once INDOT has established a procurement process, FHWA will be able to re-consider the eligibility requests for CMAQ equipment purchases.

In addition, FHWA has reviewed the respective MPO CMAQ Project Selection Processes and found it was not clear how they effectively met the following CMAQ Guidance:

- *The CMAQ project selection process should be transparent, in writing, and publicly available.*

- *The process should identify the agencies involved in rating proposed projects, clarify how projects are rated, and name the committee or group responsible for making the final recommendation to the MPO board or other approving body.*
- *The selection process should also clearly identify the basis for rating projects, including emissions benefits, cost effectiveness, and any other ancillary selection factors such as congestion relief, greenhouse gas reductions, safety, system preservation, access to opportunity, sustainable development and freight, reduced SOV reliance, multi-modal benefits, and others.*
- *At a minimum, projects should be identified by year and proposed funding source.*

The Division would like to work jointly with INDOT to ensure compliance and effectiveness of the MPO selection processes in the areas of transparency, public awareness, and prioritization based upon cost-effectiveness of projects. We would also like to modify the CMAQ form to incorporate a cost-effectiveness metric to document how cost-effectiveness is evaluated among other factors, and given priority consideration to those that will create the greatest emissions reductions for the least cost.
