## **INDOT ADA Advisory Group to Meet in West Lafayette August 13**

WEST LAFAYETTE, Ind. – The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) will hold the quarterly meeting of its Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Community Advisory Working Group on Tuesday, August 13 from 5:30 p.m. to 8 p.m. local time at the West Lafayette City Council Building, 609 W. Navajo Street, West Lafayette, IN 47906. This meeting is being held in accordance with Indiana's Open Door Law and the public is welcome to attend.

INDOT is working with its ADA Community Advisory Working Group to identify ways to enhance INDOT programs, initiatives and services in relation to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), Section 504 of the Vocational Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and all related statutes, regulations and directives.

In 2012, INDOT announced that it updated its [ADA Transition Plan](#) to include a preliminary review of state highway facilities, policies and practices in an effort meet federal regulations and requirements. During Tuesday's meeting, INDOT will present its Draft Accessible Pedestrian Signals Policy.
