- Began with introduction of the attendants and the project, in which INDOT, Boone County, and the Town of Whitestown are partners.
- The purpose of this project is to alleviate the traffic challenges and add capacity for the foreseen future growth in this area of Boone County. The project is designed to accommodate the traffic forecast for 2040. This project addresses backups related to the interchanges it will not add lanes to the mainline of the interstate.
- The goals of this meeting are to share information, including the project development process, the proposed improvements, and the past, present and future of the project status. This is intended to be an informal meeting to answer questions for stakeholders and to receive input from them.
- An explanation of the role of the Community Advisory Committee (CAC) was given. Stakeholders are included in this meeting to provide input to help inform the project development. CAC members were encouraged to share information with other members of their community.
- The project is sponsored by INDOT and the Town of Whitestown, using federal funding. The use of federal funding requires adherence to federal transportation laws including the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), which assesses the project's effects on the natural and human environment.
 - This effort includes the development of the Interstate Access Document, which includes a great deal of traffic modeling.

- It also includes an Environmental Assessment (EA). Some examples of resources addressed by the EA are wetlands and streams, historic properties (Section 106), recreation properties (Section 4(f) properties), property relocation, and noise analysis. A brief summary of impacts to these resources was given.
- NEPA requires public involvement efforts in this case, including the CAC and a Public Hearing.
 Additionally, Kitchen Table Meetings (KTMs) were performed to meet with impacted property owners for detailed communication on their individual situations.
- The project history and development since 2009 was explained.
- Alternatives for the SR 267 interchange were explained, including the partial cloverleaf, grade-separated diverting diamond, conventional diverting diamond, and single point urban interchange. It was explained that the latter two are not viable options without the CR 550S interchange, based on traffic modeling.
 - A map of the preferred alternative conventional diverting diamond was shown, as well as a video explaining traffic pathways using this system.
- Alternatives for the CR 550S interchange were explained, including the tight diamond, conventional diverting diamond, single point urban interchange, and conventional diamond interchange. Criteria for these were similar to the SR 267 interchange and the conventional diverting diamond is also the preferred alternative in this area.
- The project schedule was discussed. NEPA activities occur this year, right of way acquisition will be in 2019, and construction is tentative to begin in 2020. There may be a two-year construction season.
- Open discussion was initiated.
 - The CAC did not believe that the diverting diamond interchange would be problematic or controversial to the public.
 - o Construction of the SR 267 and CR 550S interchanges are expected to be coordinated such that traffic can be diverted to CR 550S while construction occurs on the SR 267 bridge deck.
 - o There may be a great deal of public interest, though not likely opposition to this project.
 - It is possible though not probable that some people will use this project to complain about the general development of the land.
 - People in this are generally understand the need for transportation projects. Their experience with already heavy traffic will help this understanding. The inclusion of facilities for bikers and pedestrians will help as well.
 - It was suggested that in informal period of about an hour be installed before the public hearing. That way people can have individual questions answered and perhaps diffuse some misconceptions.
 - In the public hearing it may be best to focus on the preferred alternative, and to show the other alternatives but not in detail.
 - It was suggested that the video be updated for the current project and roadways.
 - o It was suggested that affected businesses stay involved especially Amazon. Amazon's shipping during the holidays may have to be coordinated with the road work.



Your photo does not show anything after the Perry Worth intersection. What happens to the eastbound traffic after Perry Worth? The traffic eastbound after the Perry Worth Road intersection will be developed per the Whitestown Thoroughfare plan, but not a part of this project. The timing of the improvement is not known at this time. If the improvement has not be made by the time this project goes to construction, this project will just provide a stub connection for the future roadway development.

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Debbie,

Thank you for the prompt response. While I appreciate the candor from the project manager (it beats the alternative), I have a MAJOR issue with this line of thinking.

It would be beyond the pale to spend \$40+ Million to majorly expand one interchange as well as build a brand new one and NOT have it fully designed in step with a major divided 4 lane highway that's already half-built, that was planned to connect to I-65 since it was first envisioned in the 1980's. While it's INDOT's prerogative to hold such a stance it's absolutely pound-foolish—and that's even if it's somehow penny-wise. I cannot be more vehement in holding this opinion. RR Pkwy isn't some new to the table brainstorm, it's been around for over 30 years of planning, just completed the first major connection of I-74 to I-70/the airport and has enormous potential to be a huge economic drive for the west side of Indianapolis. To shrug it off as a potential way that traffic may be affected doesn't do justice to the topic.

To further my point of concern, there's a TON of commercial construction activity on 267 southwest of the I-65 interchange. I can see utilities, including power, are being shifted slightly to the west; however, it doesn't look like they're being shifted far enough to easily support a 4-lane divided highway with turn lanes. If the plan has always been to continue RR Pkwy succinctly to the 267/I-65 interchange (and it has), why wouldn't the expansion of this major, final widening of 267 be occurring in concert? How absolutely inane and inefficient would it be to have the utility companies have to relocate twice in 5 years?

I have a lot of observational insight on the current happenings, as well as direct emails from some of the county engineers, so I am up fairly up-to-speed on where things stand and in order to progress it certainly could benefit by a unifying voice leading the charge, such as INDOT was choosing to take a more active role. I think this would be wise given the likely benefit the entire state.

Anyway, I think I've touched on my point and concerns and should wrap up.

In order for me to make some of my above points, especially to have them acknowledged by more than a couple people, I presume attending tonight and speaking publicly will be the only way to truly convey strong concern?

Please let me know your thoughts on the latter, and I'll skip the family thing and make my presence tonight. Thanks

The \$4.6 million project will remove the existing overlay on the bridges and replace it with modified concrete.

Crews will use weekend lane restrictions to shift traffic through the construction site. Lanes will be reduced to two lanes. Motorists will be shifted to the outside lanes (left lanes and shoulders) during Phase I of construction. Upon the completion of Phase I, traffic will then be shifted to the inside lanes (right lanes and shoulders) for Phase II of construction. Lane restrictions will begin in July.

Thank you Debbie, technically, Mr. Cranes (I am assuming Garen is male) is making his argument to the wrong body related to the Ronald Regan Parkway. His concerns should be brought to both Boone County and The Town of Whitestown who I believe have jurisdictional control of this local roadway within their boundaries and where connections will or will not be made to other facilities. I am sure his objective can be achieved by attending upcoming Town and County meetings and voice his feeling related to the Ronald Regan. The only input or control of direction that INDOT would have, as I understand it and I am open to correction, of this local project would be where it crosses state

controlled roadways such as the structure that cross I-74 and any connections to I-74. Our input would only be related to the state R/W limits of that crossing/connection. I do not have the authority nor would I respond to INDOT taking any type of lead on local projects as suggested. That would need to go before the executive team.

To address Mr. Cranes comments related to 267 the design team based all decisions on traffic models with a year of 2040 (I will verify this with the design team but I think 2040 is accurate) and defined our Interchange R/W limits, the R/W portion of 267 and design based on those projections. We not only wanted the interchange to work the day it is open but in the future based on planned area growth. We were very aware of the current ongoing development in this area. Again, R/W, design, utility relocation and future traffic needs were all taken into consideration for the proposed preferred alternative.

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Debbie,

Thank you for the prompt response. While I appreciate the candor from the project manager (it beats the alternative), I have a MAJOR issue with this line of thinking.

It would be beyond the pale to spend \$40+ Million to majorly expand one interchange as well as build a brand new one and NOT have it fully designed in step with a major divided 4 lane highway that's already half-built, that was planned to connect to I-65 since it was first envisioned in the 1980's. While it's INDOT's prerogative to hold such a stance it's absolutely pound-foolish—and that's even if it's somehow penny-wise. I cannot be more vehement in holding this opinion. RR Pkwy isn't some new to the table brainstorm, it's been around for over 30 years of planning, just completed the first major connection of I-74 to I-70/the airport and has enormous potential to be a huge economic drive for the west side of Indianapolis. To shrug it off as a potential way that traffic may be affected doesn't do justice to the topic.

To further my point of concern, there's a TON of commercial construction activity on 267 southwest of the I-65 interchange. I can see utilities, including power, are being shifted slightly to the west; however, it doesn't look like they're being shifted far enough to easily support a 4-lane divided highway with turn lanes. If the plan has always been to continue RR Pkwy succinctly to the 267/I-65 interchange (and it has), why wouldn't the expansion of this major, final widening of 267 be occurring in concert? How absolutely inane and inefficient would it be to have the utility companies have to relocate twice in 5 years?

I have a lot of observational insight on the current happenings, as well as direct emails from some of the county engineers, so I am up fairly up-to-speed on where things stand and in order to progress it certainly could benefit by a unifying voice leading the charge, such as INDOT was choosing to take a more active role. I think this would be wise given the likely benefit the entire state.

Anyway, I think I've touched on my point and concerns and should wrap up.

In order for me to make some of my above points, especially to have them acknowledged by more than a couple people, I presume attending tonight and speaking publicly will be the only way to truly convey strong concern?

Please let me know your thoughts on the latter, and I'll skip the family thing and make my presence tonight. Thanks

MONTGOMERY COUNTY, Ind. – The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) will have lane closures on U.S. 136 beginning Monday, May 21, weather permitting. U.S. 136 will be chip and sealed from the Fountain/Montgomery County line to the Sugar Creek Bridge, just outside of Crawfordsville. Motorists are encouraged to seek an alternate route.

Depending on weather conditions, crews will be on site from 7:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day. Work is expected to last through Thursday, May 24. This work was delayed one week due to equipment issues.

INDOT crews will be applying a chip-seal treatment to preserve and protect the nearly ten miles of U.S. 136. Loose stone will be on the highway temporarily during the initial cure of the asphalt. Drivers are urged to slow down and allow additional space between vehicles to prevent stone chips from damaging windshields or paint on auto bodies.

Once the chip seal has cured, crews will sweep the highway to clear away loose stone and apply a light application of dark asphalt material to lock in remaining stone and minimize dust.




