#### *Deputy Commissioner of Innovative Project Delivery*



In October 2015, Jim Stark was appointed Indiana Finance Authority Executive Director-P3 Infrastructure. The position, which evolved from a partnership between INDOT and the Indiana Finance Authority, was created to streamline statutory processes between the two agencies. As the executive director, he manages INDOT public-private partnership (P3) projects, IFA and INDOT employees, and the Innovative Projects Program between both agencies.

Jim continues his INDOT role as Deputy Commissioner of Innovative Project Delivery, which he began in January 2013. In this position, he focuses on managing the delivery of several of INDOT's major construction projects – including the Ohio River Bridges and Interstate 69 – in the most cost-effective and efficient manner for Indiana taxpayers.

From August 2010 to December 2012, Jim served as INDOT's Deputy Commissioner for Capital Program Management, where he oversaw the costs and delivery of the department's capital program while guiding the program's project management team. He also developed INDOT's growing P3 program of innovative funding solutions and project delivery methods.

Jim also served as Deputy District Commissioner of INDOT's Seymour District from January 2009 to August 2010, where he streamlined district functions and enhanced many areas.

Jim has nearly three decades of private-sector experience in business and project management. Prior to joining INDOT in 2009, he served as a regional business analyst for American Management, and before that he was owner and CEO of Mastercraft Memorial Services.

Jim has a Bachelor of Arts degree in industrial design from Purdue University and lives in Indianapolis. In his spare time, he enjoys golfing and spending time with family and friends.

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
