






NEPA Process

Requires INDOT to analyze and evaluate the impacts of a proposed federally funded project to the natural and socio-economic environments

NEPA is a decision-making process

- Purpose and Need
- Alternatives Screening
- Preferred Alternative



NEPA Evaluation

- Right-of-way
 - No right-of-way purchasing on this project
- Streams, wetlands, and other waters
- Floodplains
- Endangered species
- Cultural resources (historical & archaeological)
- Parks and recreational lands (trails)
- Community impacts
- Hazardous materials
- Permits
- Mitigation
- Public involvement

Impacts are analyzed, evaluated, and described in the environmental document.


