PROJECT OVERVIEW





PROJECT AREA


- The US 27 bridge over the Norfolk Southern Railroad (NSRR) in Richmond is a north-south downtown connector.
 - Three local and two major collector streets under bridge
 - Two sets of railroad tracks
 - Two historic districts: Richmond Railroad HD and Star HD
- Project area runs from North D Street to North G Street







PROJECT AREA MAP







PURPOSE AND NEED

The purpose and need is the "why" for a project.

US 27 bridge replacement project:

- Needs: Deteriorated bridge, collision damage and non-ADA sidewalks.
- Purpose: Provide a sound structure and resolve safety issues from piers in busy city streets. Improve safety for pedestrians by meeting design standards, including ADA.











AN OVERVIEW

- US 27 bridge requires replacement from deterioration and collision damage.
- Replacement resolves safety issues from pier columns in crowded city streets.
- Improvements for pedestrian mobility and safety with new ADA compliant sidewalk.













IMPROVEMENTS

- Full replacement of US 27 bridge
- Improved safety for drivers and pedestrians
- Reduction in number of spans from 17 to 7:
 - Improves geometry and vertical clearances
 - Improves safety by eliminating pier from Fort Wayne Avenue
- New west side sidewalk improve pedestrian access and safety.





PROJECTED SCHEDULE

- April 2023: Work and closures begin.
- Fall 2024: US 27 and Fort Wayne Avenue expected to reopen to traffic.
- Summer 2025: Project completion.




LONG-TERM CLOSURES

- April 2023 Fall 2024:
 - US 27 from North D Street to North G Street
 - Fort Wayne Avenue from North 8th Street to North F Street (north of the railroad tracks)
- Access will be maintained for local businesses.








TEMPORARY CLOSURES

- Temporary Closures Spring/Summer 2023 and Spring 2024 through demolition and bridge steel erection:
 - North E Street from North 8th Street to North 10th Street
 - Elm Place from North 8th Street to North 10th Street
- Spring/Summer 2023: 2-day closure of North F Street at North 8th Street during sanitary sewer work on North F Street
- Spring/Summer 2023: 2-day closure of North 9th Street at North F Street during sanitary sewer work on North F Street











DETOURS




Official Detour Route

- Northbound Traffic:
 - East on South A Street, North on South 11th Street, East on East Main Street and continue east to I-70W; exit I-70W at exit 151.
- Southbound Traffic:
 - I-70 E to exit 156A, West on US 40, North on South 16th Street, west on North A Street, South on US 27.








Pedestrian Detour Route

- Northbound US 27 Pedestrian Traffic:
 - West on North D Street, North on North 8th Street, East on North G Street
- Southbound US 27 Pedestrian Traffic:
 - West on North G Street, South on North 8th Street, East on North D Street
- North E Street/Elm Place Pedestrian Traffic:
 - North 8th Street/North 10th Street to go North/South to open street when either is closed
- Fort Wayne Avenue, North F Street, North G Street:
 - North 8th Street to go North to North H Street or South to North E Street or Elm Place


