Purpose & Need



Need:

24

crashes from
2019-2024

75%

right-angle or
left-turn crashes

12

resulted in fatal
or incapacitating
injuries

Purpose:

- Improve safety by reducing frequency and severity of crashes at the intersection
- Improve mobility through the intersection



Alternatives Evaluated



No Build Alternative



- Would revert the intersection to two-way stop control
- Does not meet the purpose and need
- Not selected as the preferred alternative



All-Way Stop Control

- Likelihood of right-angle and left-turn crashes remain
- Does not address congestion challenges due to increased traffic volume
- Not selected as the preferred alternative



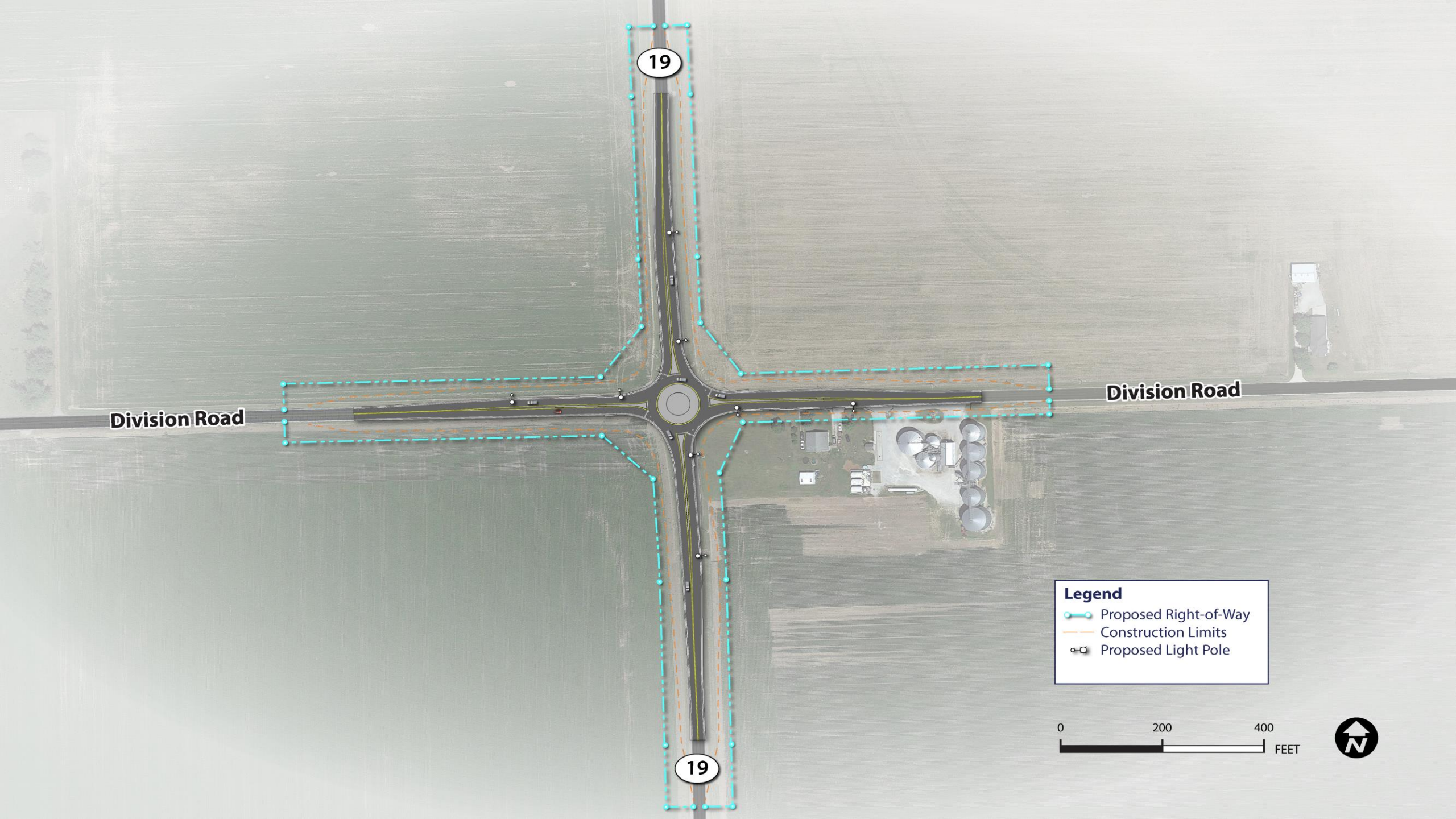
Signalized Intersection



- Current overall traffic volume does not justify a signal
- Occurrences of rear-end crashes could increase
- Not selected as the preferred alternative

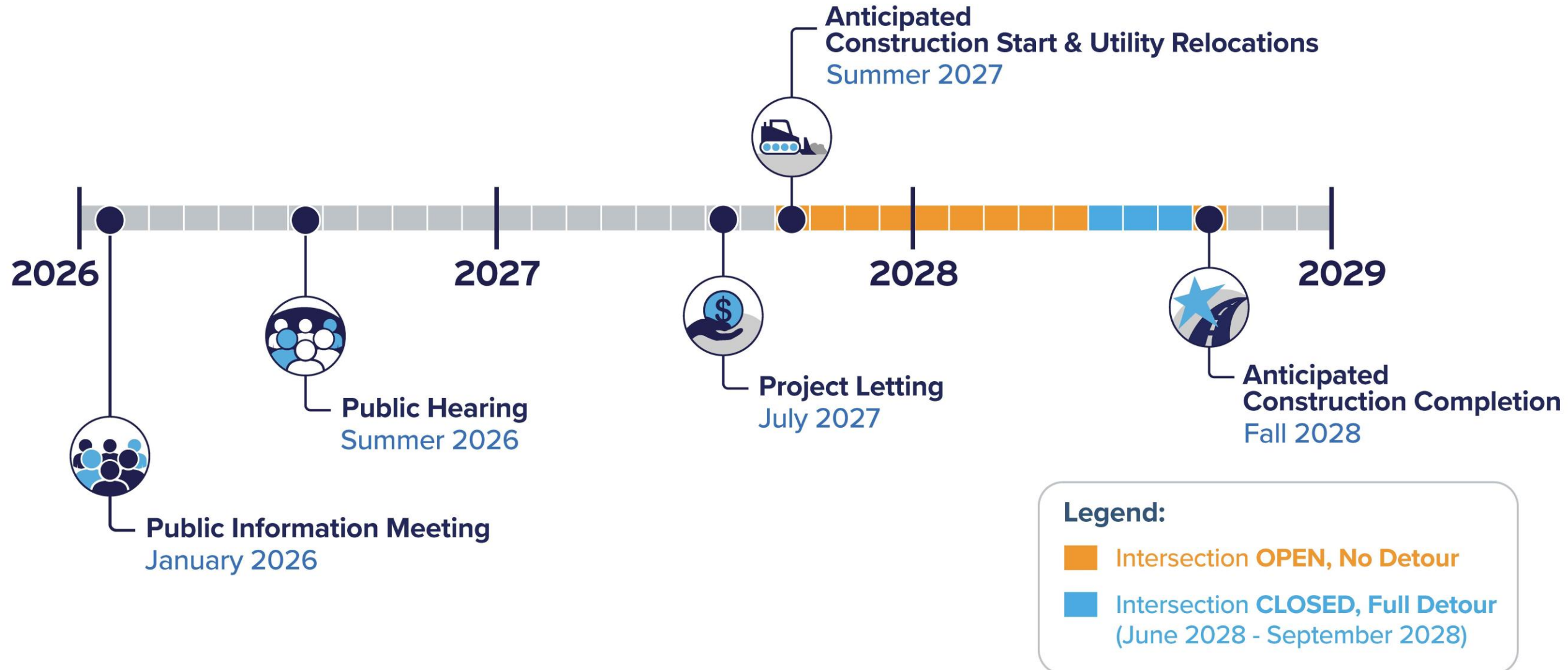
