

US 27 Bridge Replacement

PROJECT OVERVIEW


- The INDOT project will replace the US 27 bridge in Richmond.
- US 27 will be closed from North D Street to North G Street during construction.
- Fort Wayne Avenue will be closed from North 8th Street to North F Street, north of railroad tracks.
- The long-term closures are scheduled to begin on or after April 3, 2023.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Construction is expected to begin in April 2023.
- US 27 and Fort Wayne Avenue are expected to reopen to traffic in fall 2024.
- Project completion is anticipated in summer 2025.
- The Project Team is coordinating with local businesses and officials.
- Access will be maintained for local businesses during construction.
- Work is expected to happen within existing right of way.

CLOSURES


- Long-Term Closure | April 2023 Fall 2024:
 - US 27 from North D Street to North G Street
 - Fort Wayne Avenue from North 8th Street to North F Street (north of the railroad tracks)
- Temporary in Spring/Summer 2023 & Spring 2024 through demolition/bridge steel erection:
 - North E Street from North 8th Street to North 10th Street
 - Elm Place from North 8th Street to North 10th Street
- Temporary Closures (2-day) in Spring/Summer 2023:
 - North F Street at North 8th Street during sanitary sewer work on North F Street
 - North 9th Street at North F Street during sanitary sewer work on North F Street





PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Full replacement of US 27 bridge
- Improved safety for drivers and pedestrians
- Reduction in number of spans from 17 to 7:
 - Improves geometry and vertical clearances
 - Improves safety by eliminating pier from Fort Wayne Avenue
- New west sidewalk improves pedestrian access and safety
