BACKGROUND AND REQUEST:

The Indiana Department of Transportation requested an amendment to update four projects that are currently shown in the TIP, add one project that was previously programmed in the FY 2022 TIP, and add ten new projects.

INDOT targeted US 52 in western Tippecanoe County for an overlay project. Preliminary engineering was originally going to begin in FY 2023, but was moved to FY 2024.
