FY 2024-2028 TIP Amendment Area Plan Commission

Staff Report March 5, 2025

BACKGROUND AND REQUEST:

In 1978, the first long-range transportation plan for the greater Lafayette area was adopted. It envisioned a new road corridor along the western side of the communities connecting southern Lafayette to northern West Lafayette. In August of 1993, the corridor became a reality with letting of the Wabash River bridges. Through numerous construction projects that followed, US 231 now connects to US 52 on the northwestern fringe of West Lafayette.

Since the adoption of the 2025 Transportation Plan in May of 2001, the need to extend the corridor to I-65 has continually been identified. The need and proposed improvement were identified in the 2030, 2040, 2045 and 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plans. This proposed corridor improvement is part of the "ring" and "spoke" concept that was first identified in the original long-range plan. The "rings" provide easy access to the various locations around the community.

Most recently, the Wabash and Tippecanoe Townships Plan, adopted February of 2024, visions the corridor as well as developing a local road grid system.

Due to very favorable construction bids for the Morehouse Road phase 2 project, there are residual FY 2025 STBG federal funds that need to be reallocated. While some of those funds were reallocated to other projects, there is a \$340,523 balance. APC staff would like to use these funds as the federal match and take the next step to move the proposed northern corridor connection from a proposed improvement to an actual study. The specific type of study has not yet been identified, but one possibility could be a Planning and Environmental Linkages (PEL) study.

Since these are FY 2025 Federal funds, there is very little time to obligate them by INDOT's April deadline. APC staff reached out to INDOT, inquired about a funding trade, and they agreed to it. In essence, we give them our FY 2025 funds in exchange for the same amount to be used in FY 2026.

At this time, only the federal funds have been identified. The source of the twenty percent match will be identified as more details about the study are finalized.
