The Indiana Department of Transportation requests the projects listed in STIP Amendment 26-FTA-01 to be incorporated into the 2026-2029 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). 



**TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) (Public Law 117-58) designating joint Federal Highway Administration/Federal Transit Administration rules and regulations, under Section 134, Title 23 of the US Code, the act requires the annual preparation of a Transportation Improvement Program by the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization(s) as a part of the transportation planning process in urbanized areas of 50,000 or more population; and

WHEREAS, the Michiana Area Council of Governments (MACOG) being the duly designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for the South Bend and Elkhart/Goshen Urbanized Areas, in cooperation with local governmental units and implementing agencies within the urbanized areas, has prepared a Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-2028 and FY 2026-2030 Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs) which consist of improvements recommended in the MACOG Region.

WHEREAS, the FY 2024-2028 and FY 2026-2030 TIPs are consistent with the 2050 Transportation Plan (TP) and its corresponding conformity determination, which uses the MACOG travel demand model, developed with the most recently available socio-economic and other input data to estimate mobile source emissions for the conformity analysis.

WHEREAS, the MACOG Policy Board from time to time receives and amends/modifies its Transportation Improvement Program.

WHEREAS, upon review of the amendments below, MACOG here within finds that they are consistent with the 2050 TP and its corresponding conformity analysis.


WHEREAS, the proposed TIP Amendments were made available for public comment and comments received were provided to the Indianapolis Transportation Policy Committee; and

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have completed our review of the documents necessary to make an air quality conformity finding for the Indianapolis Metropolitan Planning Organization's (IMPO) planning documents. The Indianapolis Metropolitan Planning Area is within the 9-county Indianapolis air quality conformity area and is comprised of Boone, Hamilton, Hancock, Hendricks, Johnson, Madison, Marion, Morgan and Shelby Counties. The need for this new conformity finding stems from recent amendments to the FY2026-2029 IMPO Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) (Quarter 3, 2025 Amendments 26-01.2 and 26-01.3), and the CIRCLE 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) (Amendment 2).

Boone, Hamilton, Hancock, Hendricks, Johnson, Madison, Marion, Morgan and Shelby Counties are designated as Maintenance for the 1997 Ozone Standard until October 19, 2027.

Appropriate consultation and public involvement on the TIP and MTP amendments was completed. The Indiana Department of Environmental Management, the Indiana Department of Transportation, and the US Environmental Protection Agency have completed their reviews and have determined that air quality conformity requirements have been met.

Therefore, FHWA and FTA affirms the following planning documents conform to air quality conformity rule requirements:

Indianapolis MPO CIRCLE 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (Including Amendment 2)  
Indianapolis MPO FY2026-2029 TIP (Including 2025 Q3 Amendments 26-01.2 & 26-01.3)

This conformity determination letter supersedes all previous conformity determination letters for this MPO. Conformity determination letters issued for amended MTPs (i.e., MTPs that have not been updated in accordance with the requirements outlined in 23 CFR 450.324) do not restart the conformity clock for those documents.
