RESOLUTION NO. 26-30 TIP-2

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE EVANSVILLE METROPOLITAN
PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S FY 2026 - 2030 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization is the organization designated by the Governor as the Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible, together with the State, for carrying out the provisions of 23 U.S.C. 134 (Federal-Aid Highway planning requirements), and capable of meeting the requirements of 49 U.S.C. 5303 (Federal Transit planning requirements) in the Evansville Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, the Policy Committee is the policy body of the Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization; and

WHEREAS, all federally funded highway and transit improvements within the MPO planning area must be included in the MPO Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) prior to the expenditure of federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the MPO consulted with the Interagency Consultation Group and the agencies concurred in the MPO finding that the TIP amendment projects are within the maintenance area and the projects are exempt, per 40 CFR 93.126 & 127, and there is no need to update the conformity analysis or issue a new conformity finding; or the projects have been included in the most recent air quality conformity approval; and

WHEREAS, the MPO Participation Plan does not require a separate public involvement meeting for TIP amendments and conformity determinations as appropriate, and the public participation procedure was followed; and

WHEREAS, the approved amendments result in a TIP that remains fiscally constrained; and


