





### **NEPA Process**

#### Streams:

- •One stream located in the
- Unnamed Tributary to Hanger Ditch



#### Wetlands:

- Five wetlands within or adjacent to the project area
- All located within drainage ditches on US 41
- .03 acre of temporary impacts for construction access
- .05 acre of permanent impacts for placement of riprap



#### Cultural Resources:

One archaeological resource was documented



#### **Terrestrial Habitat:**

- 4.8 acres of disturbance
- No tree clearing anticipated
- No mitigation anticipated



#### **Hazardous Materials:**

• Two underground storage tanks are located

#### **Threatened & Endangered Species**

• Not likely to adversely affect endangered bat species
