Public Information Meetings US 41 Bridges and Pavement Rehabilitation Projects

The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) will hold two public information meetings for the greater Evansville, IN and Henderson, KY, communities to become acquainted with the upcoming \$25 million US 41 bridge and road rehabilitation projects scheduled to begin in spring 2017 and continue through summer 2019. The project includes rehabilitation of seven bridges as well as pavement rehabilitation between the bridge structures. The 3.8 mile project zone will require traffic lane shifts, but will allow two lanes to be open in each direction during construction phases.

A multi-phased construction plan will ease the impact to motorists and communities. Information meetings will allow the opportunity for the public to become familiar with planned construction phases.

INDOT, the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, the Federal Highway Administration, local and county agencies, and emergency services providers have coordinated construction scheduling to maintain safety and emergency services for motorist, the communities at large, and construction workers.

The purpose of these information meetings is to provide residents with an opportunity to review the project in development, including the current design, maintenance of traffic plans, and construction schedule. In addition, INDOT welcomes the opportunity to engage community members to address questions and comments. Project displays and plans will be available throughout the evenings.
