Feedback Needed on Road and Interchange Options New Maps Available at Tuesday Meeting

The Indiana Department of Transportation and the consulting firm conducting the environmental studies and engineering assessment for Section 2, Hannum Wagle & Cline and Jacobs Civil Inc., will hold a Public Information Meeting on Tuesday, August 9, from 4:30 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. at Pike Central High School located at 1810 SR 56. Beginning at 4:30 p.m., citizens may view project-related study information and speak with project team representatives regarding proposed alternatives. Project members will make a presentation at 6:00 p.m. After the presentation, the public is invited to provide comments on the information presented.

The information meeting has been scheduled to afford all interested persons the opportunity to collect information and share their input regarding the Section 2 studies for the project. Section 2 of the approved I-69 corridor begins at S.R. 64 near Oakland City and continues northeast through Gibson, Pike, and Daviess counties to U.S. 50 east of Washington.
