Indiana State EMS Commission & TIM

The Indiana State EMS Commission has been hard at work ensuring the safety of EMS professionals across the state through the TIM initiative. Over the past year, the Commission has enacted a non-rule policy requiring both new EMS professionals and those seeking re-certification to complete the 4-hour TIM training. The EMS Commission has mandated that the training be completed in one of three ways:

- Attendance in a 4-hour Class
- Completion of the NHI 4-hour program
- Online training through the ACADIS portal

The Indiana TIM Team was tasked with digitizing the existing 4-hour training, complete with voice-over narration and lesson checks. This digital version was then uploaded to the ACADIS training portal, allowing EMS personnel to complete the training online at their convenience.



By the end of 2027, more than 25,000 EMS personnel in Indiana will be TIM certified. This is a great collaborative effort between the EMS Commission and Indiana TIM that ultimately enhances the safety of both responders and motorists throughout the state.

Traffic Management Minutes

APRIL 21, 2025-I-65, JASPER COUNTY, INDIANA

A semi loaded with thousands of aerosolized spray paint cans erupted in flames after what was believed to be a mechanical brake failure. First responders to the scene described the sound of the aerosolized paint cans exploding as “gunfire”. Fortunately, the driver safely escaped unharmed.

The heat from the fully involved semi caused significant damage to the asphalt roadway. The interstate was closed for approximately 12 hours while crews assessed the scene and roadway conditions. Contractors had to repair the heavily damaged roadway prior to resuming traffic.
