

  - Engineering and Environmental Study starting in Spring 2012











### Preferred Alternative: Alternative S2-Modified

- Preferred by public
- Cost
- Reduced stream impact
- No business relocations
- Reduced impacts to residences on CR 400 W






### Middle Section

#### **Preferred Alternative:**

#### **Alternative M2**

- Preferred by public
- Fewer residential relocations
- No impact to Kipper Lane access





### **Northern Section**

#### **Preferred Alternative:**

#### Alternative N6-Modified

- Fewest residential relocations
- Does not require realignment of SR 3 (N3)
- Improved SR 3 intersection location (distance from CR 350 N)







196 acres of new right-of-way




