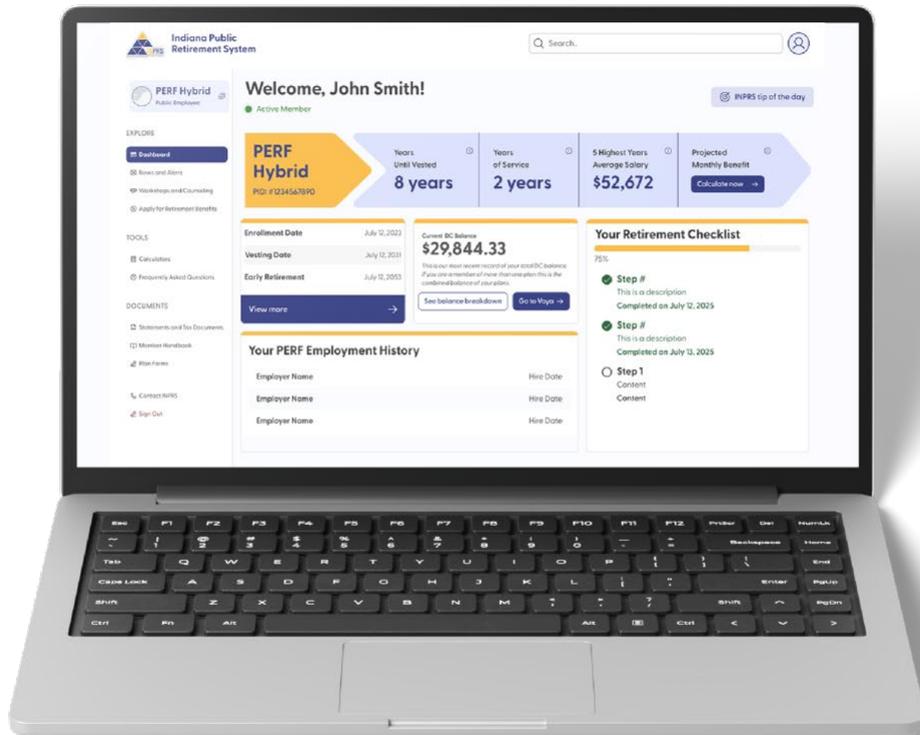




Navigating Your 1099
