FINDINGS OF FACT


1. Cynthia Reed filed her Application for disability benefits with the Mishawaka Police Pension Board of Trustees on October 23, 2000.
2. On November 22, of 2000, the Mishawaka Police Pension Board of Trustees approved her application.
3. On March 9, 2001, the Public Employees' Retirement Fund Board granted disability benefits to Cynthia Reed. This became a final determination on March 24, 2001.
4. On July 10, 2002, Cynthia Reed, through her attorney filed an appeal to the PERF Board providing medical documentation that she was no longer disabled and was fit to return to work as a police officer.
5. PERF submitted the aforementioned medical documentation to a medical consultant.
6. On September 12, 2002, R. Thomas Parker, Director, 1977 Police Officers' and Firefighters' Pension Fund determined that Cynthia Reed no longer had a covered impairment.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Cynthia Reed and her attorney acted in a timely and proper fashion to inform the 1977 Police Officers' and Firefighters' Pension Fund that she was no longer disabled.
2. The review of Cynthia Reed's medical reports was sufficient to constitute an examination within the meaning of the law.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED this 16th day of December, 2002, that Cynthia Reed no longer has an impairment as defined by the 1977 Police Officers' and Firefighters' Pension Fund.
