1. *Section 2.3.3. Organizational Capability, i. Financial Statements and Quality Assurance Report.*  
In this regard, we wanted to state that we are a private law firm that does not have publicly audited financial statements. Therefore, we want to confirm that INPRS will consider a proposal to be responsive if it is from a private law firm that does not provide a copy of its financial statements, but instead provides a summary statement regarding its annual revenues for the last two years.

**Answer:** Please provide enough information to support the financial strength of the firm. If the information provided is insufficient, INPRS will contact the firm to discuss.

2. Please confirm that the requirement to submit the Foreign Registration Statement attached as Appendix B.2 to the RFP does not apply to Indiana domiciled entities.

**Answer:** Confirmed. INPRS assumes that Indiana domiciled entities have already registered with the Indiana Secretary of State.

3. Section 2.2.4 Signature of Authorized Representative of the RFP provides: "An authorized representative of the Respondent must sign the transmittal letter. Respondent personnel signing the transmittal letter of the proposal must be legally authorized by the organization to commit the organization contractually. This section must contain proof of such authority. A copy of corporate bylaws or a corporate Resolution adopted by the board of directors indicating this authority will fulfill this requirement."

In this regard, our Firm's partners are authorized representatives of the partnership and may bind the partnership contractually. We want to confirm that we will meet the requirements under Section 2.2.4 of the RFP if one of the signatures on our transmittal letter is by a partner of the Firm, without providing any additional proof of authority (as such authority is inherent as a partner).

**Answer:** INPRS confirms that your firm meets the requirements under Section 2.2.4 of the RFP.

4. Are portfolio monitoring and securities litigation part of the scope of services even though they are not specifically named in RFP Section 3 - Scope of Services?

**Answer:** No. INPRS expects to issue an RFP for securities litigation and portfolio monitoring services in early 2028.
