Instructions for obtaining a Multi-Factor Bypass when your phone is not available

Access the Multi-Factor User Portal at <u>https://pfp.iot.in.gov/</u> and login with your user name, in the form of your Indiana State Government email address, and your password.

There may be a long wait while Multi-Factor attempts to reach your phone. The wait will be longer if you have a secondary number configured in Multi-Factor. To shorten the wait you can remove your second phone number. The wait can also be shortened if your phone is off or out of commission and the call goes straight to voicemail.

After the phone call fails, Multi-Factor will ask you to answer 3 of your 4 security questions. If you do not remember your answers, please access the user portal and re-answer your questions. After you have the answer to the questions, click the "Log In" button.

What was your high school mascot?	
What is your paternal grandmother's maiden name?	
Which phone number do you remember most from your childhood?	



After you have answered the questions, you will be logged into the portal. Click on the "One-Time Bypass" link to obtain a bypass
