

LaGrange County Investigator

The LaGrange County Prosecutor's Office is seeking a full time Investigator. This position serves as a prosecutorial investigator and law enforcement officer for the Prosecutor's Office, combining criminal investigative authority with evidentiary analysis, legal process, inter-agency coordination, and litigation support in the preparation, prosecution, and disposition of criminal and related enforcement matters.

Requirements include: High school diploma or GED required, Associate's Degree or equivalent experience and completion of Indiana Law Enforcement Academy for law enforcement officers or law enforcement academy from another state, Indiana Law Enforcement Academy's Jail Officer Course, federal agency training academy, or military police training, preferred and considered.

Pass hiring requirements including drug screening and criminal history check.

Working knowledge of criminal investigations, evidence preservation, digital evident, court operations, criminal procedure, and investigative documentation.

Benefits include: Health, life, dental, and vision insurance; State pension plan (PERF); paid time off; holiday pay; annual longevity bonus pay at end of year, employee assistance program. Pay is up to \$35.32 per hour depending on experience and qualifications.
