

Deputy Prosecuting Attorney - Level 6 Felonies

The Madison County Prosecutor's Office is hiring a deputy prosecuting attorney assigned to one or two circuit courts responsible for prosecuting Level 6 felonies, related misdemeanors, and major felony revocations

Madison County is served by 21 law enforcement agencies with more than 300 police officers. The Madison County Prosecutor's Office has a staff of 59 employees including 22 deputy prosecuting attorneys. Each year, the Madison County Prosecutor's Office files and prosecutes approximately 2,000 felonies, 500 juvenile delinquency petitions, 5,000 misdemeanors, and 6,000 infractions.

The initial annual salary for this position is between \$75,000 – \$90,000 depending on experience and qualifications. The position includes PERF and full county benefits. There is no residency requirement.

Applicants must: (1) be licensed to practice law in Indiana or eligible for immediate admission; (2) possess strong written and oral advocacy skills; (3) possess the ability to manage cases efficiently and professionally; and (4) possess a strong commitment to public service and community safety.
