

## Two Staff Attorney Positions, Indiana Supreme Court

### Staff Attorneys for Public Defender Commission and Trial Court Management

The Indiana Supreme Court, Division of State Court Administration, has two openings for a staff attorney.

The first position staffs the **Public Defender Commission**. Applicants must have five or more years of experience as an attorney to apply and have solid experience as a criminal defense attorney. The applicant should also have an affinity for working with basic statistical and financial data.

The second position is in the **Trial Court Management** section which produces the Judicial Service Report and provides support and assistance to both courts and clerks in the state. Applicants must have five or more years of experience in legal research and civil and/or criminal litigation. Essential skills for the position include a good working knowledge of the operations of courts and clerks' offices; experience in and ability to speak publicly, train and present; and ability to work independently and explore broader implications of policies and procedures.

Applicants must be members in good standing of the Indiana Bar. If you apply, please designate which position you seek (Public Defender commission or Trial Court Management attorney.) The salary will range from \$57,921.76 to \$63,941.80, depending on experience. State benefits apply.
