

## **Deputy Prosecuting Attorney**

The chosen candidate will work in close collaboration with other Deputy Prosecutors, state and federal law enforcement agencies, and victim advocates to successfully resolve criminal cases in a variety of areas. Candidates must be honest, professional, hard-working, and have a passion for prosecution and trial work. Candidates must be licensed to practice law in the State of Indiana.

A new attorney begins at \$79,393 (after the six-month probationary period) and the salary offered increases considerably based on years of experience. Deputy Prosecutors are assisted by support staff and enjoy a generous paid time off allowance, paid holidays, sick leave, and amazing medical benefits.

About the Office: the Vanderburgh County Prosecutor's Office is located in Evansville, Indiana, which sits in close proximity to Nashville and Louisville. Indianapolis is a quick two-and-a-half-hour drive north on I-69. Evansville, often described as a "little big town," is the third largest city in Indiana and home to two universities, concert venues, many restaurants, annual festivals, and sits on the riverfront of the Ohio. The Office is home to a nationally recognized digital forensic unit and was recently awarded a \$700,000 grant to open a crime gun intelligence center.
