

INDIANA COMPENSATION RATE FOR CAPITAL DEFENSE COUNSEL

Effective 1/1/1992, the Indiana Supreme Court adopted Criminal Rule 24, which governed appointment of counsel in death penalty cases. The rule required the appointment of two lawyers at trial, set out experience and training requirements, and fixed the minimum rate of hourly compensation at \$70/hour.

Effective 1/1/2001, the Court raised the hourly rate to \$90/hour, and set out a procedure for the rate to be reviewed and adjusted every two years according to an economic formula. Subsequent rates and their effective dates are set out below. The rates apply only to appointments made on or after the effective date.
