Glenn Weil presented on grant proposals to expand the project based learning initiative in Dubois County to North Spencer, Pike Central and East Gibson schools.

*There was a consensus of the Council to recommend submitting the North Spencer, Pike Central and East Gibson grant proposals to CECI.*

The Council reviewed and discussed the CTE Campaign grant proposal expanding the marketing initiative with the CTE awareness videos.

*There was a consensus of the Council to recommend submitting the CTE Campaign grant proposal to CECI.*
