

Director, Grain Buyers and Warehouse Licensing Agency (IGBWLA)

Incumbent is responsible for the management of the office of the IGBWLA. The director will cooperate and coordinate activities through ISDA and will work jointly with members of the grain industry in the State of Indiana. The Director reports directly to the Deputy Director of Agriculture. This person will coordinate the staff and duties of IGBWLA including approve new license applications, serve and fulfill the duties of Administrative Law Judge, coordinate and direct conferences with reference to violations, and issue cease and desist orders and suspensions. They will also serve as chairperson of the Indiana Grain Indemnity Corporation Board of Directors.

- o Requires Bachelor of Arts/Science degree from a college or university. Equivalent experience may substitute for educational requirements.
- o Background in Ag finance preferred.
