III. Clean Water Indiana (See Attachments)

a. CREP Report-Logan Garner

Logan has been working with partners and the CREP steering committee to make changes to some CREP practices. Changes include pool sizes in wetlands, buffer sizes, and area fed by tile drains.

b. Budget and Grants Update-Jennifer Pinkston

Jennifer gave an update on the active grants. The last round of grant reports (2012 Round II) was due on June 1. All reports were received on time and are under review.

IV. Soil and Water Conservation Districts (See Attachments)

a. Temporary Appointments

Newton-Nola moved to approve; Warren Second. Motion Passed.

V. SSCB Report

a. SSCB Chairman's Report-Larry Clemens

Larry reported the subcommittee has had one teleconference and will have the first face to face meeting on June 10. The committee is looking at how districts are funded and organized in the future. The group will have a 2 day retreat in August.

VI. ISDA Reports (See Attachments)

a. Technical Assistance-Julie Harrold

Julie reported construction season in the northeast part of the state is winding down. With the cooler weather, some waterways are still being installed. Staffs are busy with CRP activities right now. Julie has been putting together mailers to floodplain landowners eligible for CREP. RSs have been assisting with tillage transect. New 319 staff has been getting out to do site visits. Deb Jimison has been working with the SWCD doing elementary education. Dave Lefforge and Nick Alles are working with the Wabash River Basin Commission to select water testing sites.

b. Accountability & Technology-Deb Fairhurst

Deb reported the 2012 ICP reports website launched this week. All districts need to update their 2012 success stories and photos. DeeDee Sigler will be sending out the information this week. Deb is working with NRCS to create maps of the conservation workload across the partnership in July and December. Districts are encouraged to use these maps (which will be broken down by CIT regions and include NRCS, ISDA and SWCD data) when talking to county officials and doing budget requests. Larry requested Deb do a presentation at the September board meeting on these new maps.

c. Agricultural Affairs-Jordan Seger

Jordan reported On-Farm Network[©] enrollment is in process. OFN added six new groups this year, bringing the total to 18. Larry asked if the Environmental Defense Fund network is the same as Indiana's On-Farm Network. Jordan clarified-EDF runs the Adapt Network, which is similar to OFN, but a separate entity and data.

d. District Support-Jim Lake

Jim reported several DSSs have been doing out to do one on one training with SWCD staff and supervisors and assisting with tillage transect. DSSs are finalizing details for the Chair/Vice Chair workshop in August. Online registration will be up soon. Jim encourages all chairs and vice chairs to attend.

e. Water Quality-Logan Garner

Logan is working with IDEM on the nutrient reduction strategy. Larry requested Logan present the priority watersheds with an overlay of the ICP workload map at the September board meeting as this could help the board identify priorities for the upcoming grant cycles.

Jamie reported the association wrapped up legislative activities this spring. CCSI and the Hub Farm projects are going well.

f. NRCS Report – Jane Hardisty

Jane reported on her detail in Washington over the last several months. NRCS will be restructuring for cost savings and streamlining. This will include consolidation to one administrative structure across the country. NRCS will have a virtual team nationwide for administrative issues. The Secretary of Ag will use the NRCS as a possible model for other agencies to look at. Agency wide, NRCS has cut 300M this year. While other agencies have had to furlough employees, NRCS planned ahead and at this time, no furloughs are affecting NRCS. Jane reported only a handful of cooperative working agreements are still outstanding. At this time, Jane is unsure about doing any contribution agreements. Jane complimented Deb Fairhurst on her work both on the web and with the new workload maps.

Warren Baird noted the importance of Pathway to Water Quality exhibit at the fair; each SWCD should have staff and supervisors work at the exhibit.
