

Advanced Trauma Care for Nurses[®]

The Advanced Trauma Care for Nurses (ATCN[®]) course is taught concurrently with the Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS[®]) for physicians. ATCN[®] was developed to teach established standards of care and practical, life-saving skills. This advanced trauma course is designed for nurses working in Emergency Departments, ICU, Medical Surgical floors or the Operating Room who wish to increase their knowledge and practical skills in managing multiple-trauma patients.

The course includes didactic presentations coupled with lectures, corresponding practical skill stations and moulage assessment stations that demonstrate application of didactic information.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

ATCN is overseen by the Society of Trauma Nurses. This course targets experienced nurses practicing in the following areas: Pre-hospital and Aeromedical, Emergency Department, Surgical Intensive Care Units, and the Operating Room.



CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDIT

STN is a licensed continuing education provider in the State of California Board of Registered Nursing. There will be up to 19 CEUs issued along with an ATCN course certification card upon successful completion of the required material.

ATCN participants audit the ATLS lectures, including Initial Assessment; Airway & Ventilatory Management; Shock; Abdominal & Pelvic, Thoracic, Head, Spine & Spinal Cord, and Musculoskeletal Trauma; Thermal Injuries; Special Considerations; and Transfer to Definitive Care. ATCN nurse participants attend skills stations that are specifically designed to integrate the knowledge presented in the lectures. The skill stations are scenario-based and require interactive demonstration.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Registrants who cancel more than 30 days prior to the course will receive a refund minus a \$125 processing fee. Registrants who cancel 15-30 days prior to the course receive no refund but can apply the fee (less a \$125 processing fee) toward a future course. Registrants who cancel fewer than 15 days prior to the course will forfeit the entire registration.
