RE: Readoption of Health and Human Services Commission Rules

As part of the larger readoption of rules for the Indiana State Department of Health, the Health and Human Services Commission requests the Executive Board to readopt various rules in Title 410 of the Indiana Administrative Code that pertain to the programs making up the Health and Human Services Commission. A review of each rule to be readopted is attached. Those rules to be readopted are as follows:

410 IAC 3-1	Vision Acuity Testing
410 IAC 3-1.1	Vision Acuity Testing; Modified Clinical Technique
410 IAC 3-2	Lead Poisoning Testing; Sickle Cell Anemia Testing
410 IAC 3.2	CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS
410 IAC 21-1	State Cancer Registry

Following readoption by the Executive Board, a notice of readoption will be filed with the Indiana Register and the rules will not expire on January 1, 2014. The rules will continue in effect for another 7 years or until amended.
