RE: Readoption of Health Care Quality and Regulatory Commission Rules

As part of the larger readoption of rules for the Indiana State Department of Health, the Health Care Quality and Regulatory Commission requests the Executive Board to readopt various rules in Title 410 of the Indiana Administrative Code that pertain to the programs making up the Health Care Quality and Regulatory Commission. A review of each rule to be readopted is attached. Those rules to be readopted are as follows:

410 IAC 5	RADIOLOGICAL HEALTH
410 IAC 6-5.1	School Buildings and School Sites; Health and Safety Requirements
410 IAC 6-11	School-Age Child Care Facilities
410 IAC 12-1	Commercial Weighing and Measuring Devices
410 IAC 12.1	MOTOR FUEL
410 IAC 13	SANITARY BEDDING
410 IAC 16.2	HEALTH FACILITIES; LICENSING AND OPERATIONAL STANDARDS

Following readoption by the Executive Board, a notice of readoption will be filed with the Indiana Register and the rules will not expire on January 1, 2014. The rules will continue in effect for another 7 years or until amended.
