

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) and grantees in 11 other states have been awarded the Early Childhood Comprehensive Systems (ECCS) Impact grant. This five-year grant from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), Maternal and Child Health Bureau (MCHB) seeks to enhance early childhood systems building and demonstrate improved outcomes in population-based children's developmental health and family well-being using a Collaborative Innovation and Improvement Network (CollN) approach. The overall five-year aim of this project is to demonstrate a 25% increase from baseline in age-appropriate developmental skills among 3-year-old children in the IndyEast Promise Zone.

Cycle Number	PDSA Cycle #7
<u>Objective</u>	Increase developmental screening data from medical homes in 46201, 46202, 46203, 46218 and 46219 from 0% (in summer 2017) to 80%.
<u>Purpose</u>	Test
Question(s)	Which primary care physicians in zip codes 46201, 46202, 46203, 46218 and 46219 are doing developmental screenings?
<u>Plan</u>	We will call the remaining physicians that didn't respond to the survey in PDSA #5 (including the additional primary care practices that we found were missing in the 5 zip codes). We will create a spreadsheet to log the name of the clinic, the zip code, if ASQ is given (if yes at what ages), if MCHAT is given (if yes at what ages), the name of a contact person, if they have been visited by CHIPIN, and if they are doing referrals to the early intervention hubs. Our CHIPIN team members are going to begin to reach out to primary care providers to see what additional resources or training is needed.
