Re: EZFlow by Infiltrator Subsurface Trench Systems  
Revised Approval

Enclosed is the revised standard for the use of EZFlow by Infiltrator Systems EZ1203H configuration in Indiana. The issuance of this standard serves as approval for the use of the listed product in Indiana. This approval is subject to the following requirements:

1. Any changes, modifications, or substitutions of materials or specifications to the listed product must be submitted by the manufacturer and approved by the department prior the change, modification, or substitution.
2. Any revisions to the EZFlow Indiana Design and Installation Manual must be submitted to and accepted by the department.
3. The submittal to the department, on an ongoing basis (not less than annually and as required by the department), of individuals authorized to design or install onsite sewage systems containing the listed products.

If you wish to request administrative review of this Standard pursuant to Indiana Code 4-21.5-3-5, you must file a petition for review within fifteen (15) days after this Standard is received. The petition for review and petition for stay of effectiveness must be postmarked no later than February 13, 2012.

The petition for review must be in writing and must include facts demonstrating that:


- The petitioner is a person to whom the *Approval* is specifically directed;
- The petitioner is aggrieved or adversely affected by the Standard; or
- The petitioner is entitled to review under any law.

If the petition for review is not filed timely, this Standard becomes FINAL. Any petition for review and petition for stay of effectiveness must be submitted in writing to:
