- b. Certificate of Confidentiality
 - i. IRB Approved, but still waiting on the application to go through the CDC's processes

3. Data Collection Updates

- a. Death Certificates ***PRELIMINARY***
 - i. 1527 incidents as of 2/15/18, 49.7% of cases from pilot counties
 - 1. See presentation for break down
 - ii. CDC Timeliness: 98% of our death certificates were uploaded within 6 months of death!
Median days from death to initiate cases: 81 days.
 - iii. What else would you like to see from the death certificate? **Please send Rachel an email with suggestions**
- b. Coroners—Murray Lawry
 - i. 39 Data sharing agreements
 - ii. 480 records were requested. Received over 270. 73 have been abstracted.
- c. Law Enforcement—John O'Boyle
 - i. 228 Data Sharing Agreement (see handout)
 - ii. 495 requested; 390 received, 73 abstracted.
 - iii. Average time of 2 days from requesting the record to receiving it.
- d. Other Data Sources
 - i. Child Fatality Review Reports
 - 1. abstracted 14 reports into INVDRS for 2015 deaths.
 - ii. Trauma Registry
 - 1. 163 reports into INVDRS
- e. 2016 Data
 - i. 93 cases so far, this is in line with our expectations based on 2015
