SUMMARY: Voluntary Withdrawal on October 25, 2013; Meijer Supermarket is recalling 36 pounds of ground beef chuck sold between 9 am and 12am on October 22, 2013 at the Meijer store in Fort Wayne Indiana. Due to malfunctioning during processing, the meat may contain very small soft plastic pieces, black or white in color. The affected product was sold as USDA CH CAB Hamburger FP 75% LEAN 25% FAT with the first seven digits of the UPC being 2044659. The sell by date was listed as 10/23/2013.
