ACTION: Voluntary Recall; Meijer is recalling approximately 605 pounds of ground beef/ground sirloin sold on Sunday, August 18 with a sell by date of August 20, 2013 at the Meijer store in Noblesville, Indiana. The meat may be adulterated with very small soft plastic pieces. The Noblesville Meijer store has posted a notice at the meat counter, and sent a notice to consumers that may have purchased the ground beef via e-mail if available.

This recall is being sent to you for consumer inquiry only, and no action is required at this point. This recall is limited to Hamilton County as well as surrounding counties including Clinton, Tipton, Madison, Hancock, Marion, Hendricks, and Boone Counties.

**Meijer's Noblesville Store Recalls 605 Pounds
of Ground Beef/Ground Sirloin**

Meijer's is issuing a voluntary recall of approximately 605 pounds of ground beef/ground sirloin sold on Sunday, August 18 with sell by date of August 20, 2013 at this Meijer store (Noblesville, Indiana). Due to a malfunction during processing, the meat may contain very small soft plastic pieces.

The affected ground chuck was sold at the self-service counter under the following labels:
