



Sunny Start Evaluation Committee Meeting Meeting Summary

Summary of meeting:	<p>Sunny Start Report</p> <p>Daniel indicated that many participants added valuable comments and corrections. Kim Minnear was able to expand the medical home information. Daniel noted that Fig 7 shows that 2005 has a spike in infant injury mortality rate; the question of if this was due to a change in the definitions was raised. Daniel is following up on this.</p> <p>David shared some questions and comments:</p> <p>Page 11- Missy and Daniel will confirm the correction.</p> <p>Page 12- Count point time vs. children who has any time for the year (David will share his source, the difference may come from methodology).</p> <p>Page 13- Does this chart reflect the shift to Care Select during this time period to ensure that this in an unduplicated count. If children were in both programs this year which program is where they are counted, where they started or where they ended? May need to be footnoted as this was a unique situation.</p> <p>Page 15- Total eligible is not likely the same number for two different years; data will need to be corrected</p> <p>Page 17- The First Steps eligibility looks different than the CSHC eligibility, if a First Steps figure added this will get separated.</p> <p>Page 19- Why are we looking back to 1995?</p> <p>Page 36- The CSHC decrease was collapsed with First Steps, these should be separated. Has the number of children applying for CSHC decreased in this time?</p> <p>Daniel and Missy will connect with Missy to follow-up on needed data corrections</p> <p>How do we address the continued issues with dental care?</p> <p>Annual CHIP report will be coming out this spring (April?). Dental is an issue covered in this report.</p> <p>Dr. Ganser will connect with Kim Minnear and Daniel will include more information from Kim in the narrative.</p>

Daniel will plan to have final version of this for Core Partners. All comments will be due to Daniel by end of March.
For next report, will have draft in May and final after that.
For next contract year it will have reports in November and May with sharing to Core Partners January and July.

State of the Hoosier Child Report

Indicators were additionally vetted via a survey monkey. Between now and end of May, Daniel will look at each indicator and determine if data is available, at what level (state, regional and national) and what is the most current data window available.

David would like to make sure that an invitation is extended to IYI to be involved; their partnership with the Casey Foundation for the Kids Count book may make for a nice partnership and increase the circulation. The committee agreed, a structured invitation should come from the Indiana State Department of Health. Dr Ganser will extend the "ask;" David would be willing to participate in a meeting. Daniel will ask Eric Wright for a contact. We will need to add the term "young" to the name of the report.

Data Trends Covering Kids and Families

Data comes from OMPP; this is last day in the month point in time data. What level of data is needed and best to share with Sunny Start partners? Infant enrollment may be related to declining birth.

A footer can be added to main report to direct questions to David Roos. David will send these reports to committee members on a monthly basis. Trending over 12 months might be more understandable but trending 92 counties is too much data.

Reports all need a footer on each portion citing sources.
HIP enrollment went down in 55 counties in one month.

Presumptive eligibility numbers were temporarily discontinued and are not currently available. CKF and IPN are working with OMPP to increase the number of qualified providers throughout the state.

The Committee discussed how to translate the data to be meaningful, understandable and transformative to action of Core Partners, we need to get to information and action.

Could Glenna's upcoming presentation be used for Sunny Start at Core Partners?

The committee decided to include an update on CIPRA to Sunny Start Partners. Last four pages of report could be used for Core Partners, will be included in Core Partners for April.
