EMERGENCY STOP-SALE ORDER

A Representative of the Weights and Measures, Indiana State Department of Health, conducted an octane inspection at Phillips 66 motor fuel outlet located at 6271 East 500 South, Gas City, Indiana 46933 on March 14, 2014.

This inspection revealed that motor fuel sold at this outlet does not comply with the provisions of IC 16-44-3. Specifically, motor fuel described as "Premium Unleaded" which was posted as having an octane rating of 93 was tested and found to have an actual octane rating of 91.1 this is a violation of IC 16-44-3-11(1).

Pursuant to IC 16-44-3-7, and IC 4-21.5-4, you are hereby **ORDERED TO STOP SALE** of all motor fuels described as "Premium Unleaded" until such time as you have upgraded the fuels in accordance with the requirements of the Weights and Measures, Indiana State Department of Health, or until such time as the octane rating posted on all motor fuel devices dispensing "Premium Unleaded" is changed to accurately reflect the octane rating of the motor fuel delivered from these dispensers.

This ORDER is effective upon issuance.

If you wish to request a hearing on this ORDER, pursuant to IC 4-21.5-4, you are required to forward a written request to the Indiana State Department of Health, at the office of its Secretary, 2 North Meridian Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204 on or before **April 17th, 2014.**
