INSTRUCTIONS:

First, look at the list of topics. Each topic is a problem. There is space at the bottom of the list for you to add anything you feel is important that isn't listed.

Now that you've looked over the list, pick the 3 topics you think should be the very first problems that the Maternal and Child Health and Children's Special Health Care Services' should work on. Put the number 1 in the space to the left of each of those topics.

You'll do something very similar to this a few times more to complete the survey. Remember, there are no wrong answers. It is completely up to you to choose the priorities.

The second step is to pick 3 of the remaining topics and put the number 2 beside each of them.

The third step is to pick the top 4 of the topics that are left and put the number 3 beside each of those.

As you can see, the list is getting smaller and easier to choose from!

Step four is to select 5 topics out of the ones remaining and put the number 4 next to each of those.

Step 5 is to pick the 6 you think are most important out of those that are left and put the number 5 next to them.

Great! You're almost finished! There are only 15 topics left!

Now, if we could address 5 of those, which would they be? Put the number 6 next to each of those topics.

Then pick 4 out of the last 10 topics remaining and put the number 7 next to each of those.

Out of the final 6 topics, choose 3 you feel should be worked on right away and put the number 8 next to them.

Now go back to the topics that were your top 3—the ones you marked with the number 1. Pick the one you think should be addressed first, before the other two and change its number to 0.

Finally, look at the last 3--the only topics you haven't marked at all. Choose one of those to be last and put the number 10 next to it. That leaves only 2 unmarked topics. Put the number 9 next to them
