QIS Implementation Timeline

The overall planned timeline for the implementation of the Indiana Quality Indicator Survey Project is as follows:

- 2005: CMS launched QIS Demonstration Project
- 2006 – August 2009: CMS began QIS training in 11 states
- August 2009: CMS issued survey letter indicating implementation timeline for remaining states
- August 2, 2010: ISDH participated in CMS Information Call on initial preparations for QIS implementation
- November 2010: ISDH began scheduling and preparations for QIS training
- January 2010: Training of first two ISDH QIS teams begins
- April 2010: Training of first two ISDH QIS teams completed
- April 2010: Training of ISDH QIS Trainer completed
- May 2010: Second surveyor group training begins
- December 2014: QIS training completed for all long term care surveyors

The following is a planned timeline for the initial Indiana QIS training and implementation:

- December 13, 2010: CMS QIS Overview Conference Call with health care facilities
- January 10, 2011: Core classroom training begins for initial surveyors

- January 18, 2011: Core mock survey
- January 24, 2010: 1st survey of record
- Feb 7, 2011: 2nd survey of record
- April 4, 2011: Train-the-trainer (T3) workshop

The Quality Indicator Survey process was developed for the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) as a computer assisted long term care survey process. The process is designed to increase efficiency and consistency of certification surveys.

Indiana is the next state to begin implementation of the Quality Indicator Survey (QIS) process. The ISDH begins training its first ten surveyors on the process beginning January 10, 2011.

The ISDH invites all Indiana long term care facilities (nursing homes) as well as long term care provider associations and organizations to participate in a Indiana QIS Overview Conference Call. The purpose of the call will be to provide an overview of the QIS process and implementation plan. The Conference Call will be hosted and presented by Nursing Home Quality who is serving as CMS' project manager for the QIS program.
