24-2-1	There is body damage which could cause injury to persons near the bus (e.g. jagged metal edges, etc.)((Exigent circumstance can be taken into consideration to allow the bus to return home in a post crash inspection if bus is out of its district)).	Passenger side, near rear bumper has exposed gap/ metal edge due to collision damage.
8-2-1	There is no brake certification, or the certification has expired or is not signed	
62-2-1	Two (2) or more taillights or brake lights do not function (LED lights are considered non-functional if 50% or more pixels are inoperable in one light.)	Both tail lights on driver side has 50% or more diodes out. Bottom taillight on passenger side has 50% or more diodes out.

## Bus Type Description

**Type A School Bus - A conversion or body constructed upon a van-type or cutaway front-section vehicle with a left side driver's door, designed for carrying more than ten (10) persons. The term includes two (2) classifications:**

1. **Type A-1, with a gross vehicle weight rating of ten thousand (10,000) pounds and under.**
2. **Type A-2, with a gross vehicle weight rating over ten thousand (10,000) pounds.**
