### Violations - Rejected

| <u>Inspection Code</u> | <u>Description</u>  |
|------------------------|---|
| 13-1-1                 | Any clearance light is missing, cracked, faded, wrong color, or inoperative   |
| 90-1-2                 | The trash container is greater than a fourteen (14) quart capacity  |
| 90-1-3                 | The trash container is not secured to prevent movement and does not allow for easy removal and replacement                            |
| 22-1-1                 | A dripping oil or fluid leak  |
| 7-1-5                  | See Notes: Any defect inspector deems a violation not listed  |
| 64-1-4                 | Any front turn signal does not function properly  |
| 44-1-1                 | Any marker light or lens is missing, cracked, faded, wrong color, or inoperative  |
| 34-1-1                 | Any headlight is inoperative  |
| 36-1-1                 | The latch does not secure the hood tightly  |
| 4-1-2                  | See Notes: Any defect inspector deems a violation not listed  |
| 11-1-2                 | The front or rear bumper is not properly attached, missing, torn, loose, or altered.  |
| 24-1-2                 | The bus body has loose, damaged or improperly aligned body parts. These would include rivets, bolts, and body panels and/or rub rails |
| 68-1-3                 | Reservoir is empty  |

### Violations - Out of Service

| <u>Inspection Code</u> | <u>Description</u>   |
|------------------------|--|
| 14-2-1                 | Any crossmember is cracked or broken   |
| 24-2-2                 | Any body surface protrudes beyond the normal limits of the body structure  |
| 62-2-1                 | Two (2) or more taillights or brake lights do not function (LED lights are considered non-functional if 50% or more pixels are inoperable in one light.) |

### Bus Type Description

**Type C School Bus - A body installed upon a flat back cowl chassis with a gross vehicle weight rating of more than ten thousand (10,000) pounds and designed for carrying more than ten (10) persons. All of the engine is in front of the windshield. The entrance door is behind the front wheels.**
