Opportunity for Public Comment on Duke Energy Rate Case

WHAT: The Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (Commission) will hold a field hearing in Bloomington to hear from the public on the petition of Duke Energy Indiana, LLC under [Cause No. 46038](#).

WHEN: June 20, 2024, at 6 p.m. local time

WHERE: Monroe Convention Center in the Olcott Young Room
302 South College Avenue, Bloomington, IN 47403

WHY: Duke Energy filed a petition before the Commission requesting approval to increase its rates and charges for electric utility service and approval of certain related relief.

HOW: During field hearings, ratepayers have the opportunity to speak directly to the Commission or submit written comments. Please note, though, that because this is a pending case, the Commissioners and Judge are not allowed to answer questions or engage in any discussion about the case.
