- 5.2.3.2 Rate Zone: A Rate Zone is a geographic area that comprises a specific incumbent Local Exchange Carrier's (ILEC's) operating territory within the state. All usage rates and charges will be assessed based on the operating territory of the Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier ("ILEC") from which a call originates or to which a call terminates. Zone 1 is the operating territory of Ameritech/AT&T. Zone 2 is the operating territory of Frontier. Zone 3 is the operating territory of Cincinnati Bell. For those calls that originate or terminate in any area of the state not within an identified zone, the Zone 1 rates will apply.
