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GAS BILLS TO DECREASE FOR CUSTOMERS OF OHIO VALLEY GAS CORPORATION

Today, in Cause No. 37352 GCA 77, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission approved the gas cost adjustment requested by Ohio Valley Gas Corporation for the months of February, March, and April 2003. The new factor will result in a decrease on customer bills.

Ohio Valley Gas Corporation serves customers along the Texas Gas Transmission mains in Greene and Knox Counties; Arthur, Ayrshire, Campbelltown, Winslow, and rural areas in Pike County; Cass, Curryville, Dugger, Farmersburg, Hymera, New Lebanon, Shelburn, Sullivan, and rural areas in Sullivan County; and Blackhawk, Riley, and rural areas in Vigo County; all in Indiana.
