GAS COSTS EDGE DOWN FOR CUSTOMERS OF INDIANA NATURAL GAS

Today, in Cause No. 37418-GCA 85 the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission approved the Gas Cost Adjustment for May, June, and July 2005 requested by Indiana Natural Gas. Customers will pay slightly less than last quarter, and nearly the same as this time last year. The table below shows the impact on customers.
