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IURC APPROVES DECREASE IN FUEL CHARGE FOR INDIANAPOLIS POWER AND LIGHT

Today, in Cause No. 38703-FAC 61, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission approved a request by Indianapolis Power and Light to change its fuel cost charge for December, 2003 and January and February, 2004.

The average customer, using 1,000 kWh per month, should experience a **decrease** of \$1.63 per month or 2.46% on his or her electric bill.

The IURC has found that Indianapolis Power and Light has made every reasonable effort to acquire fuel and provide electricity to its retail customers at the lowest fuel cost reasonably possible.

Indianapolis Power and Light provides electric service to approximately 450,000 retail customers located principally in the City of Indianapolis in Marion County and in portions of the following Indiana counties: Boone, Hamilton, Hancock, Hendricks, Johnson, Morgan, Owen, Putnam, and Shelby.

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
