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### **IURC APPROVES CHANGE IN FUEL CHARGE FOR LOGANSPORT ELECTRIC**

Today, in Cause No. 38705-FAC 64, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission approved a request by the Logansport Electric Utility to change its fuel cost charge for October, November and December, 2004.

The average customer, using 1,000 kWh per month, should experience a **decrease** of \$9.83 per month on his or her electric bill.

Evidence submitted in this case supports the company's claim that Logansport Electric has made every reasonable effort to provide electricity to its retail customers at the lowest fuel cost reasonably possible. Logansport Electric is still operating under restraints from the Environmental Protection Agency and must purchase coal with low sulphur content. The company says this has increased costs.

Logansport Electric serves nearly 13,000 residential and business customers.

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
