IURC APPROVES EXPANSION OF TERRITORY FOR WYMBERLY SANITARY WORKS, INC.

Today in Cause 42510, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission approved a settlement agreement between the Indiana Office of Utility Consumer Counselor and Wymberly Sanitary Works, Inc., which expands the company's certificate of territorial authority in Floyd County, Indiana.

The Commissioners agree that allowing Wymberly Sanitary Works to serve customers in the proposed Springwood Heights subdivision and the existing Floyds Knobs Elementary School is in the best interest of the public.

The settlement also sets a new rate for the new commercial class of customers for Wymberly. The rates will not change for the residential customers, and the current rate of \$32 dollars will be charged to new customers in Springwood Heights.

Wymberly currently serves 340 customers in Floyd County, Indiana.
